Bath Package

The Bath Transportation Package (BTP) is a bus-based package of measures designed to improve public transport options and reduce the impact of and reliance on private car travel in the World Heritage City of Bath.

In accordance with DfT guidance, Bath & North East Somerset Council is reviewing the design specifications and scope of the BTP in order to identify any further opportunities to reduce costs, enhance value and improve deliverability. This work continues under the authority's newly-appointed administration, with a view to submitting the most competitive and high value for money scheme for Bath.



Prior to the CSR the scheme was already at an advanced stage, having secured all relevant planning consents. A full tendering exercise had also confirmed affordability and deliverability of the project.

The current review is likely to reduce further the requirement for third party land-take, (and the need for any Public Inquiry) reducing costs and further improving deliverability and timescales for implementation.

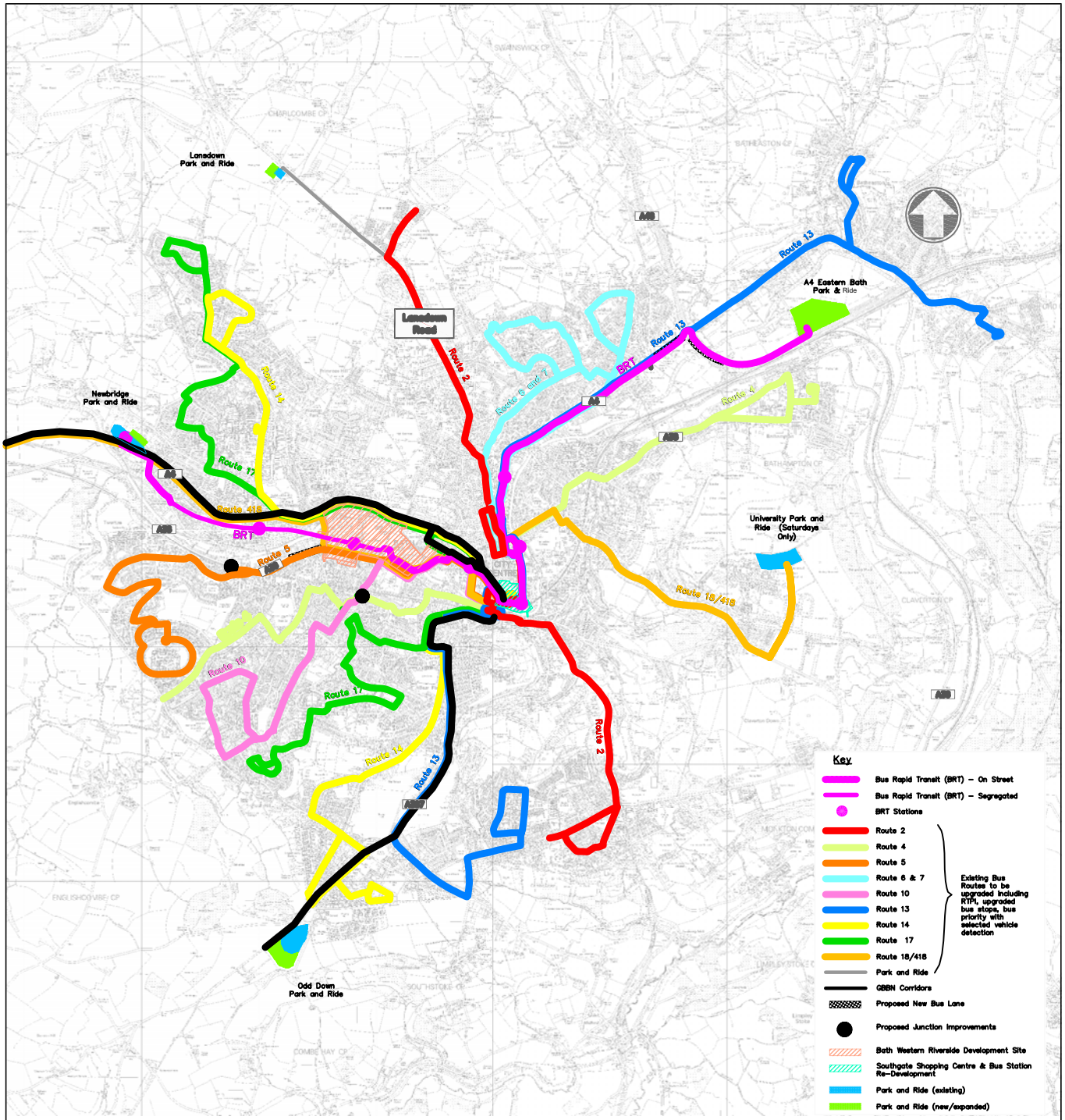
